Things You Need To Bring

- Polarized Sunglasses
- Waders that fit, preferably not neoprene, as they can be uncomfortably warm in the summer heat
- Insect repellent
- Sunscreen
- Hat or baseball cap
- Shorts and T-shirts
- Long pants, long sleeved shirts and a sweatshirt or two
- Rain gear! Thunderstorms get us off the water; rain does not!
- Several pair of old shoes
- Extra socks and underwear
- Disposable camera: Labeled!!
- Beach towel
- Swim suit
- Extra clothes/ wading shoes if planning to wet wade
- Fishing equipment: rod, reel (4, 5 or 6 weight) line, leader*
- Fishing vest if you own one
- Laundry or garbage bag for dirty clothes
- Shampoo, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, and antiperspirant
- Positive attitude

**If you do not own a rod, one will be provided for you.*

Note: All clothing and equipment should be properly marked with the owner's name. Also remember that items that come to camp looking new will not look that way when they get home.

You will be at the Ralph A. MacMullan Conference Center for 5 days and 4 nights. Please pack accordingly and bring appropriate quantities of clothing, shoes and foul weather gear for the duration of the camp. Bedding and pillow are provided.
