



## **2012 MICHIGAN YOUTH TROUT CAMP RULES**

- Only staff vehicles are allowed in camp.
- Campers are expected to remain with the Camp group at all times.
- All visitors must have prior STAFF approval.
- Phone communications along with Internet use is allowed only with specific staff permission.
- All injuries must be immediately reported to a staff member.
- It is mandatory that campers will refrain from use of tobacco, alcohol, as well as illegal drugs.
- Campers violating the above rule will be immediately expelled from camp.
- Report all lost and found items to a staff member.
- Please leave cell phones and pagers at home.
- Campers are expected to respect and encourage their peers. Intimidation of your fellow campers will not be tolerated.
- Name badges must be worn at all times.
- The camp was designed as a once in a lifetime learning experience. The curriculum doesn't change substantially from year to year and there would not be value for the camper or the program to allow campers to return. We do not run the camp as a for-profit enterprise and the cost per camper far exceeds what we charge. While we appreciate the interest it doesn't fit the stated purpose of the camp.

From time to time in the past we have asked former campers to return as junior counselors and counselors but this has always been on a merit basis.
