2017 Michigan Trout Unlimited Youth Trout Camp Rules

- 1. Only staff vehicles are allowed in camp.
- 2. Campers are only allowed in their own rooms and common areas. Campers are not allowed in other campers' or counselors' rooms.
- 3. Campers are expected to remain with the Camp group at all times.
- 4. All visitors must have passed Trout Unlimited's background check, have prior approval from the Camp Director, and remain in the company of a Trout Camp Staff Member at all times while in camp.
- 5. Phone and internet use is **only** allowed with specific staff permission and **only** while in the common area at the Ralph A. MacMullan Conference Center.
- 6. No phone, data or camera use is allowed in campers' rooms.
- 7. Any injuries must be reported to a staff member **immediately**.
- 8. The use or possession of tobacco, alcohol, and/or illegal drugs is prohibited. Campers violating this rule will be expelled from camp immediately.
- 9. It is the responsibility of the Parent/Guardian of a Camper found in violation of Camp Rules to pick up the Camper immediately upon notification by the Camp Director.
- 10. All prescription drugs must be in original containers and taken under the supervision of the designated Trout Camp Staff member.
- 11. Report all lost and found items to a staff member.
- 12. Campers are expected to respect and encourage their peers. Intimidation of your fellow campers, in any form, will not be tolerated.
- 13. Name badges must be worn at all times.
